The Embassy would like to inform your office that beginning 05 December 2022, all travelers to the Philippines, including returning residents, will be required to provide their arrival information and health declaration through the **eTravel** platform at: <a href="https://etravel.gov.ph">https://etravel.gov.ph</a>.

Registration at the *eTravel* portal replaces the paper Arrival Card and One Health Pass system.

## LAUNCH OF ETRAVEL **PLATFORM**

The public is informed that starting today, 05 December 2022, all inbound travelers, including returning residents, of the Philippines will be required to provide their arrival information and health declaration through the following portal:

## https://etravel.gov.ph

The eTravel registration, which may be accomplished within three (3) days before arrival in the Philippines, replaces the Bureau of Immigration's paper Arrival Card and the One Health Pass.
